#### Directions:

From Hartford – I-84 East to Route 384 East (exit 59) to Route 6 East  
Route 6 becomes Route 66 East 2.6 miles to Main Street/Route 66 (slight right)  
Continue on Main Street .8 miles to parking lot on left.

From New York and Points South – I -95 North to I 91 North to I – 84 East (Exit 25). (*Follow directions from Hartford above*).

From Providence and Points East – Route 6 West becomes Route 66. Stay straight on Main Street (Route 66) approximately 3 miles to parking lot on right.

From Norwich and New London – Route 395 North to Route 32 (Exit 25) Route 32 to right over "Frog Bridge". Take left on Main Street to parking lot on right.
